Subject: Request to alter schedule for hearing topic 031 Historic Heritage - UPDATED

The panel has considered your request in the joint memorandum dated 19 February 2015 to amend the hearing topic 031 Historic Heritage schedule and include further mediation on this topic.

The request has been accepted and the provisional schedule will be updated accordingly. The panel have accepted the additional mediation date and the new dates for the hearing, however, the evidence exchange dates proposed in the memorandum have been altered by the panel. The new dates are:

- An additional mediation date will be held on Monday, 23 March 2015
- Council evidence in chief is now due 15 April 2015
- Submitter evidence in chief is now due 24 April 2015
- Rebuttal evidence is now due 6 May 2015
- Notice of cross-examination is now due 11 May 2015
- Hearing will be held on Thursday 14 and Friday 15 May 2015

In addition to the above amended dates, the panel has also requested that the:

- Heritage Working Group provide a fortnightly progress report to the Panel
- Auckland Council provide an updated marked-up version of the relevant sections one week prior to the additional mediation date.

All submitters who wish to be heard on this topic will be advised and invited to attend the mediation.
